GB Instructions - 1,2,3... Have fun and learn with all of LazyTown's inhabitants!
$1-10$ consist of 36 puzzles: 10 puzzles of 2 pieces and 26 puzzles of 3 pieces.

- Ten puzzles that consist of two pieces are about counting.

There is a number on one of the pieces and on the other a corresponding number of similar pictures.

- Nine puzzles that consist of three pieces are about counting and adding up.

On one of the pieces, for example, there are two apples and on the next another two apples. On the third corresponding piece, there is a picture of four apples.

- Nine puzzles that consist of three pieces are about counting and adding up. Just like the previous series. The assignment and the solution are, however, depicted by means of pictures with the corresponding number.
- Eight puzzles, which consist of three pieces, are about adding up numbers. For example, $5+4=9$.

Lay the individual pieces of the puzzle on the table with the pictures face upward. Do the puzzles together with your child. Begin with the first set. Sooner or later, your child will want to do the puzzles on his/her own.
