1. Visit the iTunes app store and download the free application, Pool Billiards by Jumbo. You can search for the game by its name "Pool Billiards for iPawn" (by Jumbo), by "iPawn" or by developer "Jumbo".
2. Launch the Pool Billiards iPad application.
3. Place iPad on a stable, flat surface.
4. To have the best interactive experience make sure that you are holding the iCue with two or

more fingers and support it with your other fingers on the iPad. Ensure that the contact of the iCue rest flat on the iPad and makes contact. Slide the iCue to hit a ball.



5. iCues are made of strong, durable and abrasion-resistant material. iCues don't scratch under normal use. Make sure that your iCues are clean and dry when using them on your iPad. Please note that when used on a protection sheet it might leave small marks.
