

Card game for 2 - 6 children from 3 years of age.

Contents:

28 cards

Brief description:

With this game, children from 3 years of age can recognize the motifs or dots on a dice and allocate them accordingly. The game is best played on a large table or directly on the floor.

Preparations:

The cards are removed from the pre-punched boards. All the cards are placed face down and well shuffled. The cards are then dealt out to the players. 2 up to 6 children can play this game.

The cards are dealt out as follows:

2 players: each player receives 8 cards

3 players: each player receives 6 cards

4 and more players: each player receives 4 cards

The remaining cards are set aside face down where each player can easily reach them. These cards make up the general stock.

How to play:

Players draw for the lead which is won by the highest score. The leader plays first by placing any chosen card face up on the table. Each player plays in turn. The next player must place a suitable card next to the first card so that the two adjoining motifs, as well as the dots, match up. Each player can play one card after the other, as his own stock of cards allows. If he does not have a suitable card to play, he must take a card from the general stock. If the card is suitable, he plays it. If not, he takes it into his own stock.

End of the game:

The winner of the game is the first to have played all his cards. If they are already capable, the other players then count up the value of the motifs and dots on the remaining cards to establish the further placings.
